**Proposal for adjustment and enhancement of existing internal structural ties; temporary removal for specialist repair/conservation of a section of stained glass from the eastern window of the Egyptian Hall and installation of a temporary replica panel; and consolidation of vulnerable decorative plaster in the principal and second floor reception rooms in the north and central areas of the building,  
at Mansion House, Mansion House Street, London, EC4N 8BH.**

**Notice Under Regulation 6 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Regulations 1990**

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Take notice that an application is being made to the City of London Corporation by London Underground Limited ('the Company') of 55 Broadway, Westminster, London SW1H 0BD for listed building consent in respect of the listed Mansion House at Mansion House Street, London, EC4N 8BH.

Particulars of the proposed works are: adjustment and enhancement of existing internal structural ties; temporary removal for specialist repair/conservation of a section of stained glass from the eastern window of the Egyptian Hall and installation of a temporary replica panel; and consolidation of vulnerable decorative plaster in the principal and second floor reception rooms in the north and central areas of the building. The location of Mansion House is shown on the attached plan.

Under section 17 of the Transport and Works Act 1992 this application will be referred to the Secretary of State for Transport for determination. This is because the Company is applying to the Secretary of State for Transport under section 6 of the Transport and Works Act 1992 for The London Underground (Bank Station Capacity Upgrade) Order under section 1 of that Act. This Order would authorise the Company to construct works at Bank Station in the City of London for the purposes of creating additional passenger access capacity, circulation and interchange to the Company's Northern line underground railway at that station and to also improve emergency fire and evacuation protection measures. The listed building consent is required for the purposes of proposals included in the application for the Order.
