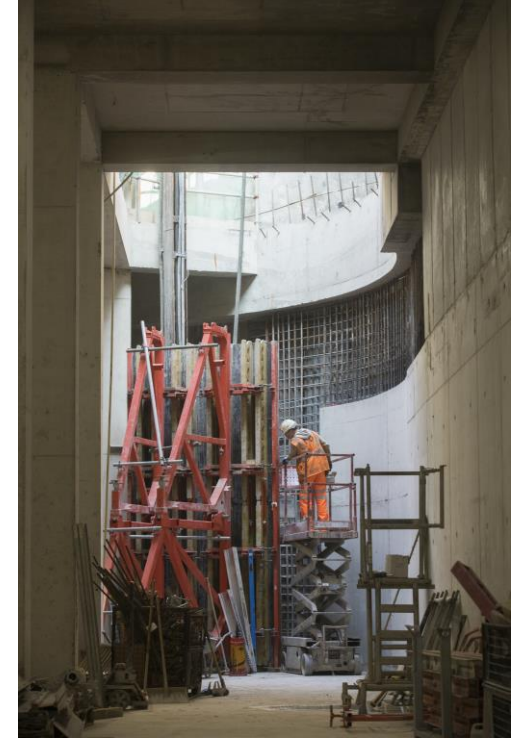


Track installation and tunnel fit out works on going between Kennington Park and Nine Elms Station

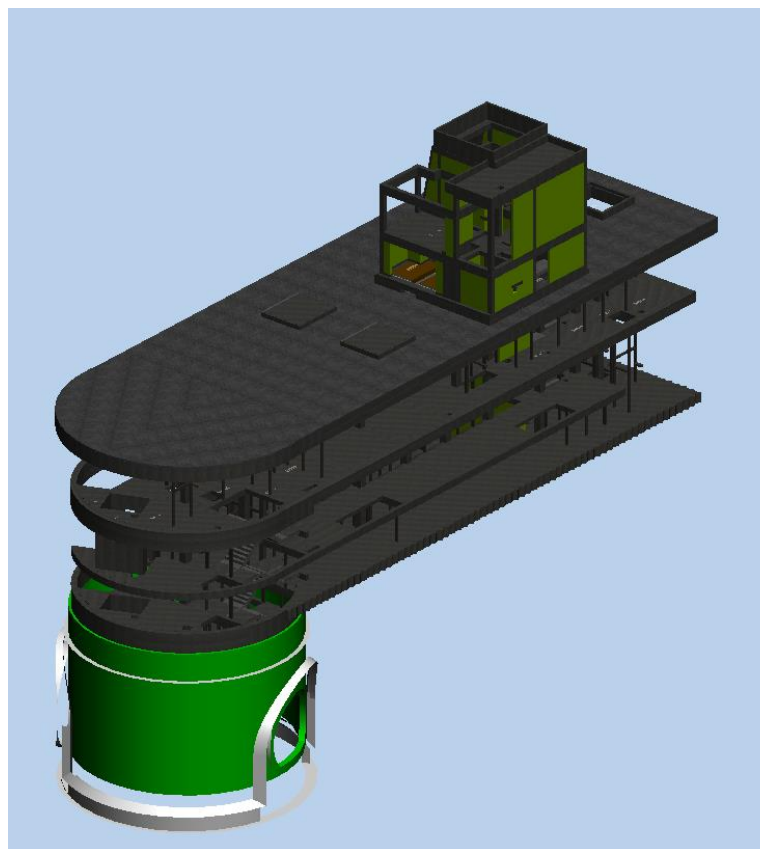
What is coming up in the next 3 months

In the tunnel

- Complete conductor rail installation
- Tunnel fit out works will continue with cable and pipework installation

In the basement

- Continue with the main structure of the basement
- Commence the brickwork facade of the headhouse
- Complete the utility connections from the headhouse structure to the street. – *Kennington Park Place and St Agnes Place*

Utility works scheduled to take place at the on Kennington Park Place and St Agnes Place – <i>date change to align with UKPN and Thames Water works</i>	June 2019	July 2019
Mechanical & Electrical Installation of equipment inside the headhouse structure	February 2019	Spring 2020
Hard and Soft Landscaping Kennington Green – removal of remaining foundations and concrete surface from site, removal of hoardings etc	Early Spring - Summer 2020 <i>Actual planting dates will be reviewed with our specialist suppliers</i>

- We continue to Work Related Road Risk (WRRR) driver training awareness for vulnerable road users, IE cyclists.
- 100% WRRR compliance is being maintained.
- Once abnormal deliveries have been authorised by the metropolitan police we alert the residents under section 61 explaining the reasons for either working early/late. In addition, there are no planned abnormal loads at present.
- Montford Place continues to be the holding area for deliveries for Ken Park and Ken Green sites
- April – July '19 will be mainly lorries with blocks and steelwork & light plant delivery lorries.
- Approx. 8-10 lorries per day.

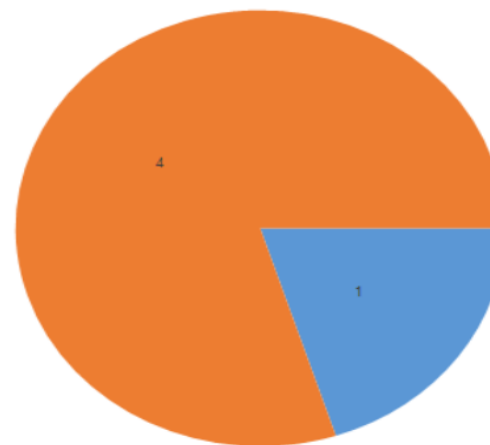

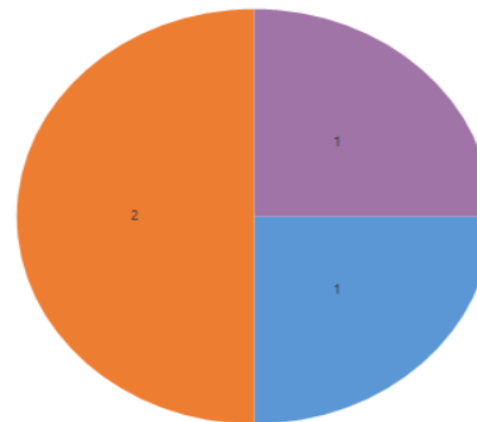

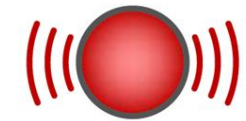

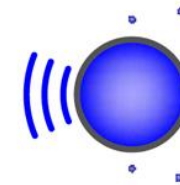


Environmental Monitoring Locations

MONITORING POSITION

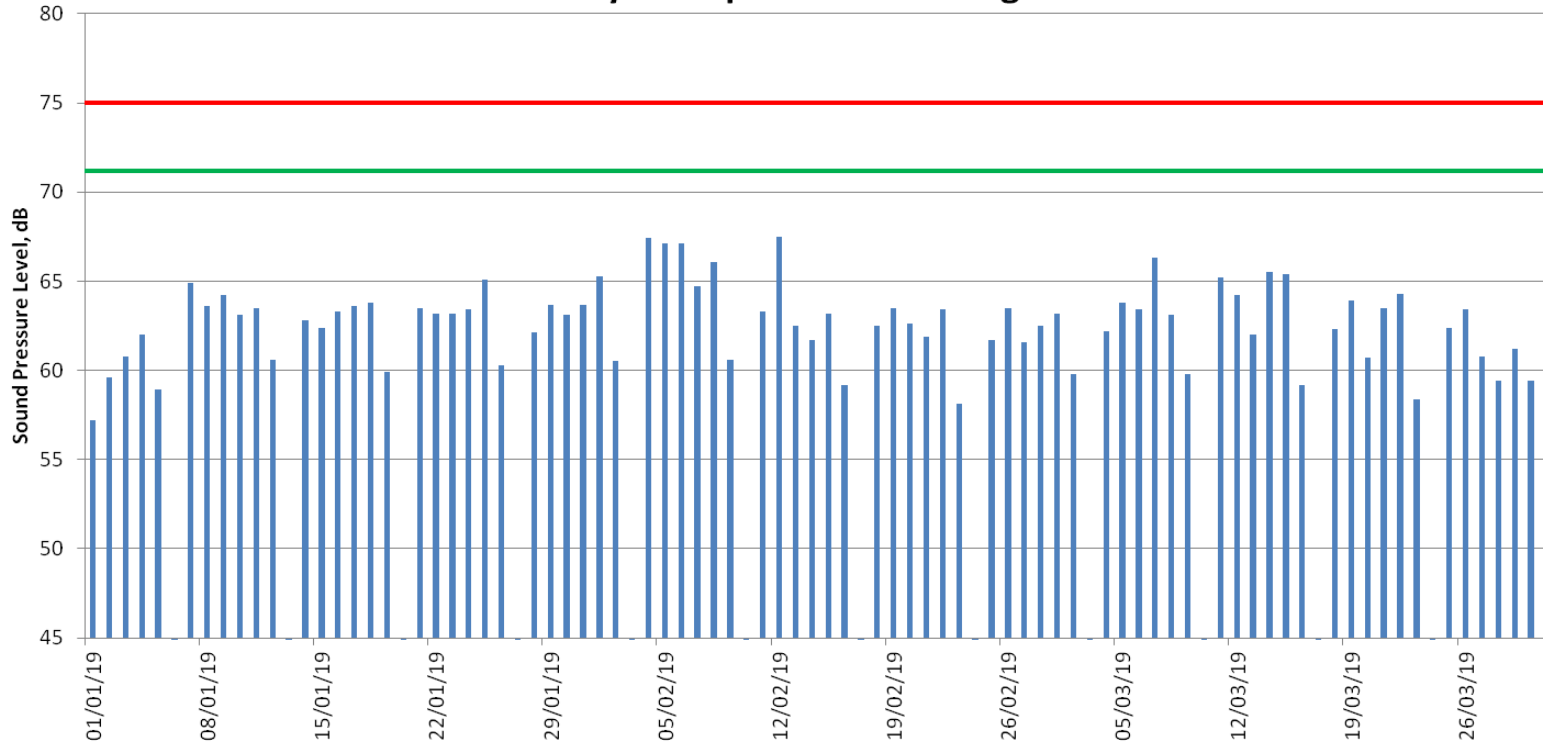

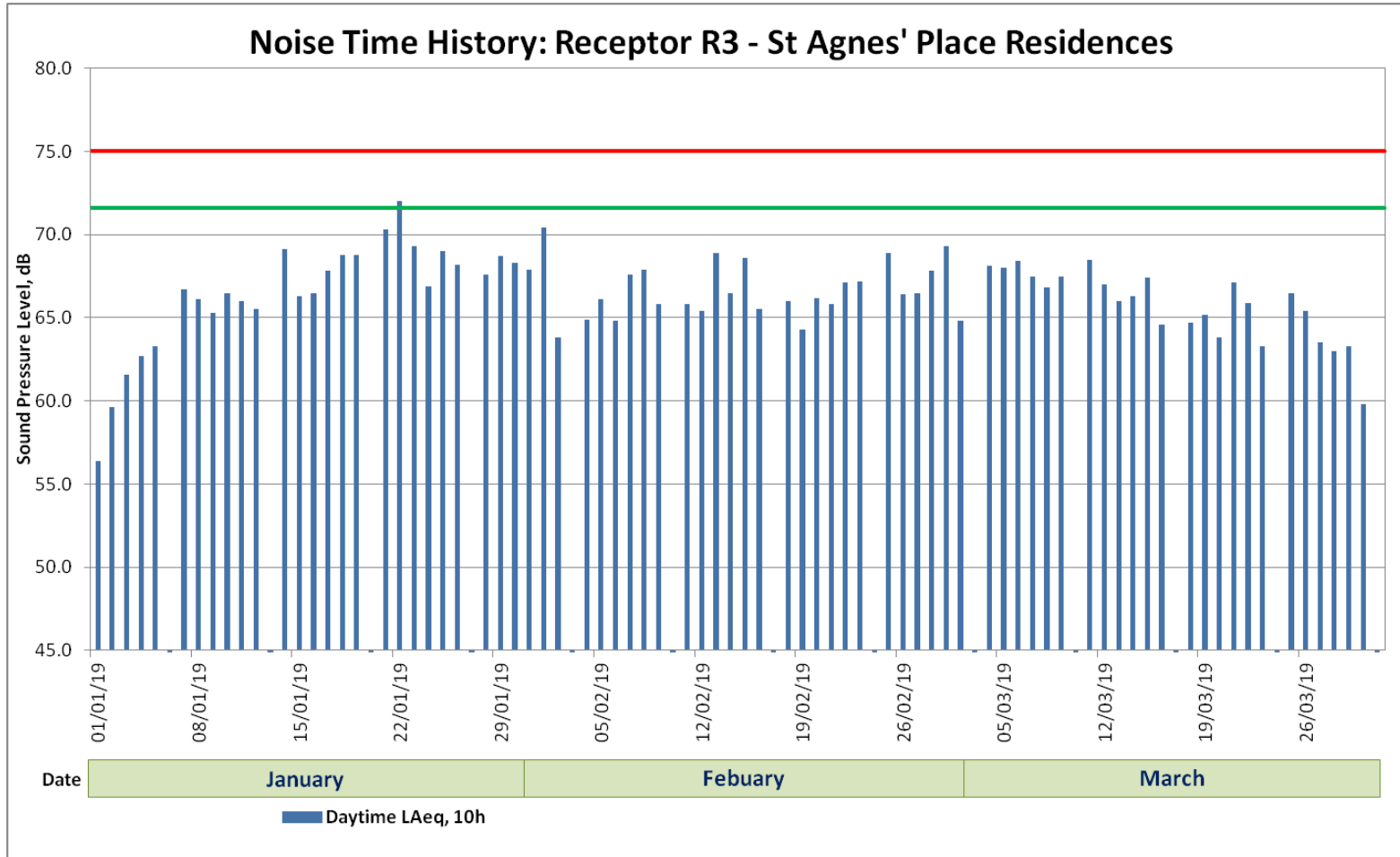

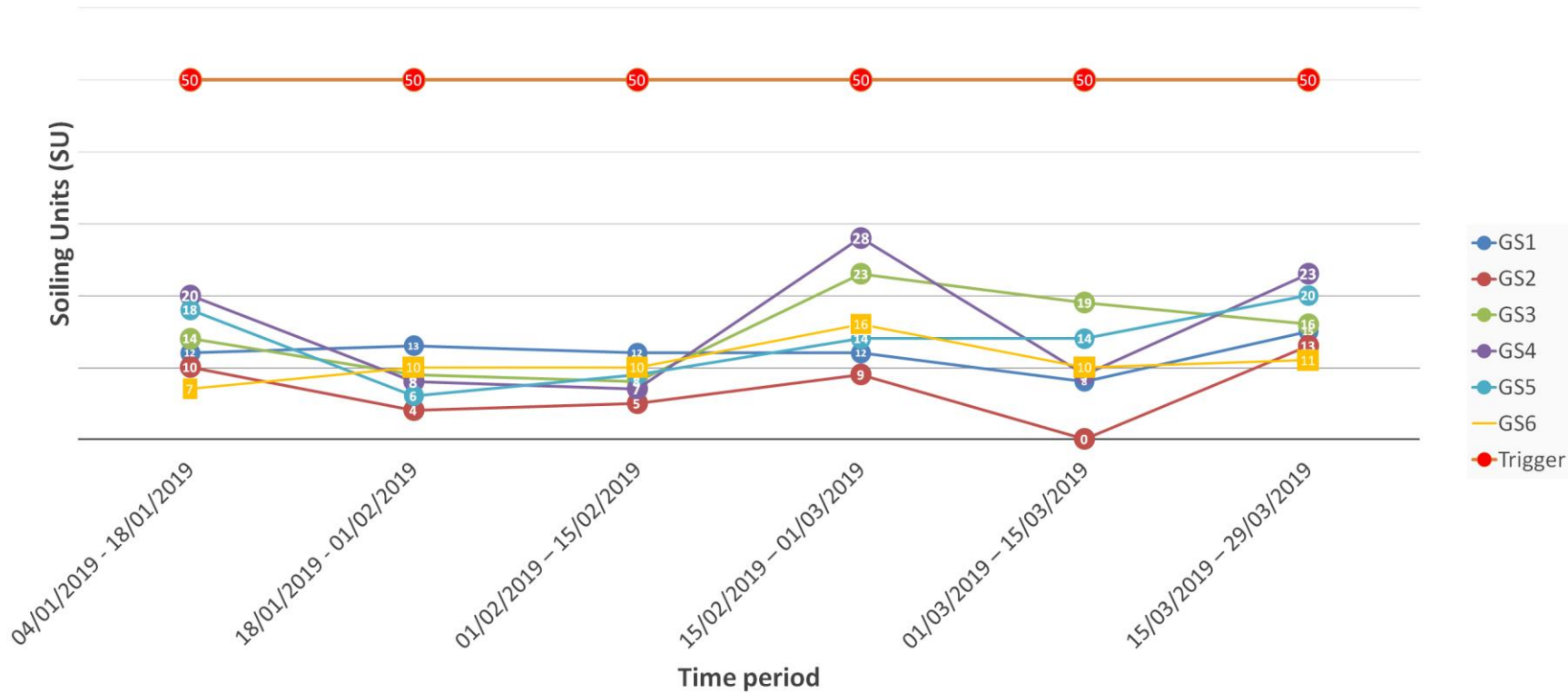
