1 Summary

- 1.1 The purpose of this paper is to seek the Board's approval for the reappointment of a non-executive director to the Crossrail Limited (CRL) Board.
- 1.2 A paper is included on Part 2 of the agenda, which contains exempt supplemental information. The information is exempt by virtue of paragraph 2 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 in that it contains information that reveals an individual's identity, prior to a decision being taken on their appointment.
