

1. Table 2 below summarises the amount of funding being allocated to London Local Authorities, for transport schemes, following assessment of their 2006/07 Borough Spending Plan (BSP) submissions.

2. The right hand side of the table summarises the allocations to authorities for the Financial Years 2006/07 and the commitments for 2007/08, 2008/09 and 2009/10. The left hand side of the table splits the 2006/07 allocation figures across transport topics identifying the types of schemes for which support has been provided.
