Background

Huge growth in London's population - growing by almost two million people (combined populous of Birmingham & Leeds) by 2031

Increasing demand with rise from current 26 Mn to over 31 Mn trips every day

Ever diverse requirements on space with huge increases in cycling, demand for new public spaces and less traffic-dominated streets

More roadworks with a boom in property investment and development activity



Background

Road improvement plans, including hundreds of transformational projects



Responsibility for road operation & improvement poorly understood and little checking / pre-planning behaviours amongst road

users (19% road users claimed to always or regularly check before a journey vs 80% public transport users)

- ❖ CS East-West (Lancaster Gate to Tower Hill)
- ❖ CS North-South (Elephant & Castle to Farringdon)
- ❖ CS2 (Aldgate to Bow)
- ❖ CS3 (Barking to Tower Gateway)
- ❖ CS (Oval to Pimlico)
- ❖ CS7 (Merton to City)
- ❖ CS8 (Wandsworth to Westminster)



And this year...

- A1 Islington – works at Highbury Corner
- Tooley Street - **closed eastbound** May 2016 to February 2018
- Tideway - works at Nine Elms Lane, Chelsea Embankment (+ more later)
- High Speed 2 - utility works start near Euston from Summer 2016
- Bank junction scheme – starts May 2017

A202 - Vauxhall Bridge Rd. (Southwark - SE1) Partial closure

Vauxhall Bridge Rd. is closed between Vauxhall Cross and Victoria station, due to an emergency services incident. Traffic is slow moving, with delays along the Embankment.

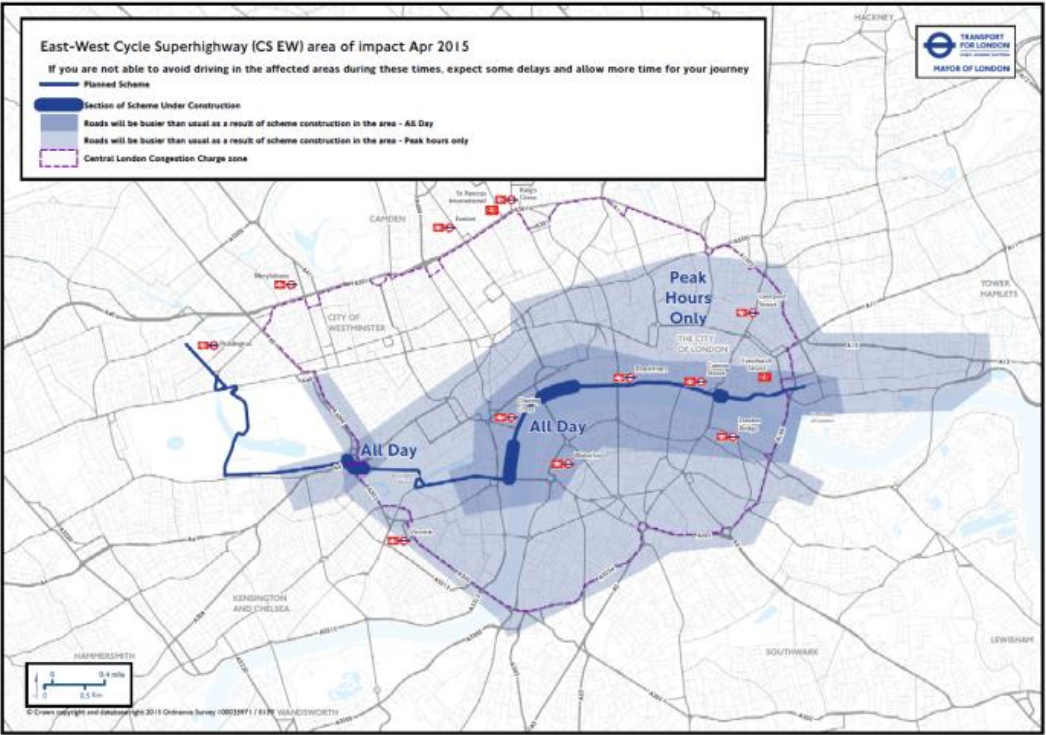

Hanger Lane
Various lane restrictions are in place between 22:00 and 05:00 each night until early June in all directions at the Hanger Lane gyratory. This is for resurfacing works.

Victoria
From 21:00 on Friday 31 March until 05:00 on Monday 3 April, the junctions of Bressenden Place and Buckingham Palace Road will be closed. This is for resurfacing works. Additionally, the junction will be closed from 21:00 until 05:00 on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, and there will be lane restrictions on Bressenden Place during the day.

Camden
From 09:30 on Tuesday 4 April until 16:30 on Wednesday 5 April, there will be lane restrictions on Camden Road at the junction of St Pancras Way. This is for utility works.

West London
On Sunday 2 April, the annual Boat Race will take place on the River Thames between Putney Bridge and Chiswick Bridge. Between midday and 19:00, delays are expected in the areas surrounding Putney, Hammersmith and Chiswick Bridges.

Wembley
From 11:30 until 18:30 on Sunday 2 April, roads around the stadium will be busier than usual, including A406, Harrow Road and Wembley High Road. This is due to a sporting event.

Hounslow
From 11:00 until 18:00 on Sunday 2 April, there will be delays and road closures in the area, including on Wellington Road South northbound, Bath Road eastbound from the A4, and Staines Road eastbound from Green Lane. This is for a procession.

Advise drivers to take appropriate care – bikes will be coming from both directions



Delivering across a quietway

Quietways differ in that they are part of the urban realm in many cases and share space with pedestrian areas.

Again drivers need to take appropriate care – bikes, as well as pedestrians, will be coming from both directions



Signage



Loading bays will in the main have the following signage if they are on a red route.

Loading bays have been provided on the edges of cycle superhighways and may have other loading restrictions.
