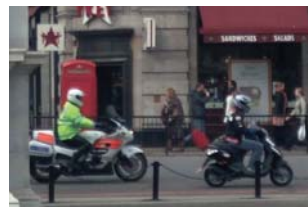




What is BikeSafe-London?

In London, motorcyclists represent a disproportionately large number of casualties – while representing under 2% of road traffic they account for nearly 24% of deaths and serious injuries.

BikeSafe-London was launched in April 2003 as a result of a partnership between the Metropolitan Police Service, the City of London Police and Transport for London. BikeSafe-London aims to reduce casualties by educating motorcyclists and encouraging them to take further training to improve their riding skills and abilities.
