



Traffic Radio

Transport for London (TfL) has invested in London's version of 'Traffic Radio', a Highways Agency initiative to bring information to listeners in London about traffic disruptions and major road works on the TfL road network. It is available on digital radio and on the internet 24 hours a day.

TfL will play an essential role in providing London-specific information about conditions on the road from the London Traffic Control Centre.

The information will be updated every 10 minutes during peak times and every 20 minutes at other times. This new service will enable road users to pick up detailed information on road conditions, keeping them better informed and helping them to plan their routes and to decide when best to travel.

This is a valuable resource to all road users and should prove useful to the taxi and private hire trade in London

Road users can access Traffic Radio at www.trafficradio.org.uk or by tuning into the 'Traffic Radio' station on a DAB radio.

This service will complement TfL's online traffic news service currently available at www.tfl.gov.uk/trafficnews, which gives details on scheduled public events, road works and congestion, including information on accidents and emergencies.
