



### **Supplementary Notice 6: under bonnet fires in TX4s Removal of licence suspensions and remedial work by LTI**

Further to PCO Notice 35/08 issued on 27 October 2008, the PCO can now confirm that remedial work on all TX4s whose licences were suspended has now been completed. This work was completed on 11 November 2008.

Whilst this was a very important milestone for all concerned, LTI will continue to contact affected vehicle owners to attend Mann and Overton in order that remedial works can be completed on all remaining TX4s licensed in London as quickly as possible and in an orderly manner, in ascending VIN order. This will fulfil the commitment given by LTI to further minimise the risk of under bonnet fires in later TX4s.


LTI has informed the PCO that some owners who have been contacted by Mann and Overton are demonstrating a reluctance to make their vehicle available for this remedial work to be carried out. Affected owners must make every effort to have their vehicles attend for this remedial work on the appointed date in order that LTI can complete this recall in a timely manner.

The PCO has agreed with LTI that completion of remedial works must adhere to two key dates. In support of achieving appropriate completion of this work by these dates the PCO will now take the following actions:

- All TX4s up to VIN 203500 must have remedial works completed by 16 January 2009. LTI will notify the PCO of those vehicles failing to have this work completed by this date and the Licensing Authority will consider suspension of licence on affected vehicles.
- All TX4s up to VIN 205838 must have remedial works completed by 13 March 2009. LTI will notify the PCO of those vehicles failing to have this work completed by this date and the Licensing Authority will consider suspension of licence on affected vehicles.

The PCO would like to reaffirm its thanks to every affected vehicle owner for your co-operation during this very difficult period but would urge all affected owners to respond promptly and positively to LTI when they are invited in for the work to be done.
