



**Wimbledon Tennis Championships 2008  
Arrangements for private hire vehicles**

This note outlines the arrangements which will be in place for private hire vehicles serving customers visiting the 2008 Wimbledon Tennis Championships.

As in previous years, there will be stopping and waiting controls in force around the ground and these will be strictly enforced. Stopping will be prohibited on Church Road and Somerset Road. Private hire vehicles cannot use the facilities that have been designated for taxis.

Locations for dropping off and picking up passengers for the Tennis Championships are:

- Wimbledon Park Road: on the east side of the road, parking bay 4092 opposite 418 Wimbledon Park Road (just north of the junction with Bathgate Road and Victoria Drive);
- Marryat Road: on the west side of the road from 10 metres north of Burghley Rd to a point opposite 66 Marryat Rd.

Signs at these locations will indicate that private hire vehicles are allowed to stop to drop off or pick up passengers. Parking and waiting at these locations is not allowed. If drivers expect to wait for passengers they must use the car parks or wait further away and make arrangements to be called to the pick-up point when the passenger is ready.

Public Carriage Office staff will be in attendance through the Championships as well as parking enforcement officers from the local authorities.
