

## HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

### THE TRANSPORT FOR LONDON (RIVER ROAD) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2009

Transport for London acting under an agreement with the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham pursuant to section 8 of the Highways Act 1980 makes this Order in exercise of its powers under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf:

1. (1) Transport for London is authorised in relation to River Road in the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham to:
    - (a) construct a new highway along the route whose centre line is shown on the Site Plan by an unbroken black line surrounded by stipple;
    - (b) stop up each private means of access to the premises described in the Schedule and shown on the Site Plan by a solid black band; and
    - (c) provide new means of access to premises at each location shown on a Site Plan by thin diagonal hatching.
  - (2) Where a new highway is to be constructed wholly or partly along the same route as a new access or part of one, that new highway shall be created subject to the private rights over that new access.
  - (3) The new highway is given a reference letter on the Site Plan, which is also placed in the Schedule, and will be a road. Each new access is given a number on the Site Plan, which is also placed in the Schedule.
  - (4) Where a new highway is to be constructed or a new access is to be provided in connection with the stopping up of a private means of access described in a Schedule, its reference letter or number (as the case may be) is placed in that Schedule opposite the description of that length or access.
  - (5) The Site Plan shows the works indicated in the Schedule and the route of the classified roads in relation to those works.
2. The new highway given reference letter A in the Schedule and on the Site Plan with the words "temporary highway" placed in brackets beneath, is a highway to be constructed for temporary purposes and Transport for London is authorised to close that temporary highway at the end of seven days from posting a notice at each end of the temporary highway to indicate that it is no longer needed for public use.
3. In this Order:
    - (a) All measurements of distance are measured along the route of the relevant highway or private means of access to premises as the case may be;

- (b) “the classified road” means River Road which Transport for London proposes to improve through the provision of a dedicated bus route starting at the junction with the A13 East Ham and Barking Bypass and finishing at Thames Road and which is a highway which is a classified road in accordance with section 12 of the Highways Act 1980;
- (c) “new access” means a means of access to premises authorised by this Order to be provided;
- (d) “new highway” means the highway authorised by this Order to be constructed;
- (e) “Schedule” means the Schedule to this Order
- (g) “Site Plan” means the site plans bound together and numbered 1 and 2 marked The Transport for London (River Road) (Side Roads) Order 2009 sealed with the Common Seal of Transport for London and deposited at Transport for London, Palestra, 197 Blackfriars Road, London SE1 8NJ, Thames View Library, Sue Bramley Community Centre, Bastable Avenue, Barking, IG11 0LG and London Borough of Barking and Dagenham’s Town Hall, 1 Town Square, Barking, IG11 7LU, a duplicate of which has been deposited in the Offices of the Secretary of State for Transport.
