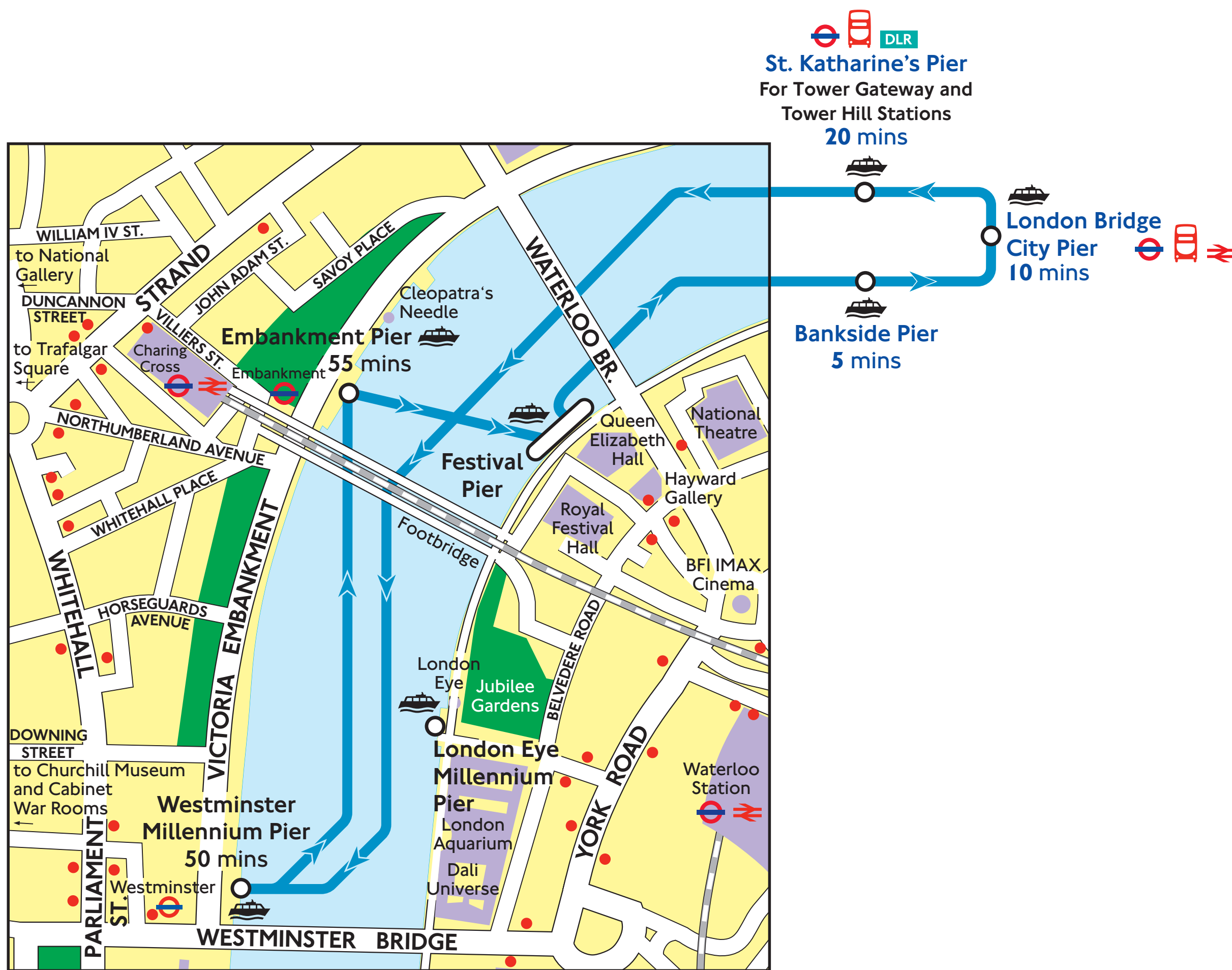


Boats from Festival Pier
