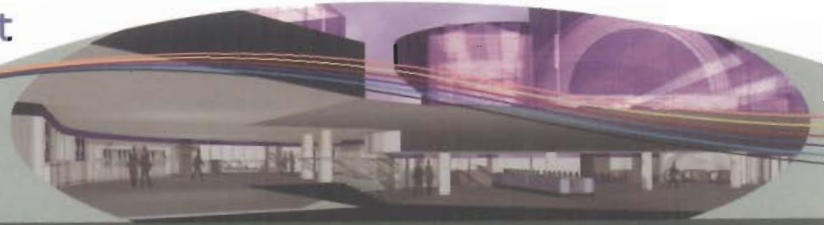


# King's Cross St. Pancras Underground station development

### Tube Ticket Hall

Works within the enlarged ticket hall are essentially complete with minor snagging works ongoing. Final fit-out and commissioning works are nearing completion in readiness for the opening of the new ticket office and station control centre.

The new Tube Ticket Hall facilities are scheduled to open in Spring 2006.

### Euston Road Pedestrian Subway

Works within the new pedestrian subway underneath Euston Road are complete. When the new Western Ticket Hall opens, the original public subway, with direct access to the Metropolitan, Circle and Hammersmith & City Line platforms, will close. This will allow the area to be refurbished as a 'ticket only' part of the station.

### Western Ticket Hall

Construction works have been completed. Final fit-out, systems testing and commissioning are now under way.

The new ticket hall is scheduled to open in Spring 2006, doubling the capacity of the station with additional ticketing facilities and direct access to the Metropolitan, Circle and Hammersmith & City Lines.

The reinstatement of Euston Road and Pancras Road pavements for pedestrian use is nearing completion. Associated traffic management changes will occur during this time.

Specialist repairs and reinstatement of the heritage structure that fronts the ticket hall on Euston and Pancras Roads are ongoing.

### Northern Ticket Hall

Phase 2 of the Project involves the construction of a new Northern Ticket Hall, located to the west of King's Cross mainline station. This ticket hall is designed to provide additional capacity once the Channel Tunnel Rail Link domestic services are operating to and from St Pancras Station.

In addition to increased capacity, Phase 2 will also provide step-free access from the surface through to the deep level tube lines.

Initial preparatory works are due to commence in Summer 2006.

### Metropolitan, Circle and Hammersmith & City Line platform closures

Refurbishment of the platforms for the above mentioned lines is ongoing. As a result it is necessary to implement a number of weekend closures, which will take place on the following dates:

- 11<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> March 2006
- 18<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup> March 2006
- 1<sup>st</sup> - 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2006
- 8<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> April 2006
- 14<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup> April 2006
- 29<sup>th</sup> April - 1<sup>st</sup> May 2006
- 6<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup> May 2006
- 13<sup>th</sup> - 14<sup>th</sup> May 2006
- 20<sup>th</sup> - 21<sup>st</sup> May 2006

At these times customers are advised to use available bus routes and that London Underground tickets will be accepted on Thameslink services between King's Cross and Blackfriars.
