What is ScooterSafe-London?

Building on the successful BikeSafe- London programme, launched in April 2003, ScooterSafe-London, which is a partnership between the Metropolitan Police, the City of London Police and Transport for London, aims to target riders of smaller capacity machines. Whether they are 16 year olds on their first moped or regular commuters on larger machines, everyone can still benefit from a day with the team.

What's involved?

Powered two wheel riders are invited to attend a Rider Skills day. These days combine observed rides, led by serving police officers, with interactive presentations and discussions looking at riding in the urban environment.

Whether you ride a small capacity motorcycle, a scooter or a moped, you will get useful advice and information on how to improve your riding skills.

Introducing ScooterSafe-London

In London, riders of powered two wheelers under 250 cc make up nearly half of all casualties.

ScooterSafe-London is designed to address this issue by inviting riders and pillion passengers of small capacity motorcycles, scooters and mopeds to attend a Rider Skills Day.
