**Transport and Works Act 1992  
The Transport and Works (Applications and Objections Procedure) (England and Wales) Rules 2006  
Proposed London Underground (Victoria Station Upgrade) Order**

Application is hereby made by London Underground Limited ("LUL") for an Order under sections 1 and 5 of the Transport and Works Act 1992, the purpose of which is to authorise the carrying out of works to enhance Victoria Underground station, comprising a new sub-surface ticket hall beneath Bressenden Place, the expansion of the existing Victoria line ticket hall beneath Wilton Road, new lifts, sub-surface escalators and pedestrian links, and for that purpose, the acquisition, compulsorily or by agreement, of land and rights in land and to use land.

The overarching objective of the scheme, known as the Victoria Station Upgrade (VSU), is to increase capacity at the Underground station in order to deal with the serious congestion that currently occurs at the station and to meet forecast demand. The scheme is also intended to reduce journey times, improve the quality of access and interchanging at the station and generally improve the ambience of the station. In addition, step free access routes from street level to all platforms will be provided.

In connection with the application, a direction is also being sought under section 90(2A) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
