Requirements

 You must test all new tfl.gov.uk websites against the scope defined below, making use of the entry and exit criteria, and scoring defects using the severity criteria.

Who	TfL nominated 3 rd Party Service Provider		
Scope	Perform one or more of the following types of Performance testing:		
	Load Testing – Understand the performance of the system under specific load		
	Stress Testing – Understand the upper limits of capacity within the system		
	Soak Testing – Determine if the system can sustain the continuous expected load		
Entry criteria	Development is complete		
	Load and performance requirements are defined		
	Environment is stable during testing period		
	Environment has correct data and content loaded		
Exit criteria	All tests run to completion		
	All defects identified have been recorded and assigned a severity		
Defects	Sev 1: business-critical Issue – dramatically failing to meet our targeted KPI's (system cannot go live unless this requirement has not been met)		

- Sev 2: high importance, failing to meet our targeted KPI's but we have short term work around to improve performance (system can go live if this requirement has not been met, but a workaround must be in place, together with an action plan for meeting KPI's)
- Sev 3: medium importance, just falling short of our targeted KPI's (system can go live if this requirement has not been met, but there must be an action plan for meeting the requirement by an agreed date)
- Sev 4: low importance, Minor differences in our targeted KPI results (system can go live if this requirement has not been met, but there must be an action plan for meeting the requirement by an agreed date)
