


Context

- I MOSAIC Driver has been developed as a geo-demographic segmentation applicable to the whole of London
- I It is based on aggregating individual MOSAIC Types into more practicable segments
- I An underlying assumption is that differences in places are largely accounted for by differing mixes of the segments
 - This is recognised as a simplification
 - Richmond is particularly unusual and so we wished to test this assumption



MOSAIC DRIVER and MOSAIC in Richmond





Richmond Driver: profile of resident population




Travel by car (as driver)







Mode shares (Richmond residents)




Purpose share for key modes





Car ownership (2001)




