DBS Update Service

It is a **mandatory** licensing requirement that anyone now applying for a taxi or PHV driver licence (both new and renewal) is required to provide evidence of registration with the <u>DBS Update Service</u>.

There are two opportunities to register with the DBS Update Service:

- 28 days from when you apply for your enhanced DBS check
- 30 days from the date when your DBS certificate was issued

If you miss the windows to register, then you will need to apply and pay for a new enhanced DBS check.

Whitehall

On Saturday 20 April, Whitehall will be closed for a significant part of the day for a wreath laying event.

Central London

From 07:30 until 15:30 on Saturday 20 April, the TCS Mini London Marathon 2024 will take place, with the route contained on Horse Guards Road, Birdcage Walk, Spur Road and Constitution Hill. Large crowds and increased traffic levels expected along the route.

Trafalgar Square

From 12:00 until 18:00 on Saturday 20 April, a religious event will take place on Trafalgar Square. Large crowds are expected.

Twickenham Stadium

From 12:00 until 19:00 on Saturday 20 April, Twickenham Stadium will be hosting the Women's Six Nations rugby match between England and Ireland, with kick off at 14:15. Large crowds and increased traffic levels are expected before and after the match.

Wembley Stadium

From 15:00 until 22:00 on Saturday 20 April, Wembley Stadium will be hosting the FA Cup Semi Final football match between Manchester City and Chelsea, with kick off at 17:15. Large crowds and increased traffic levels are expected before and after the match.

From 13:00 until 20:00 on Sunday 21 April, Wembley Stadium will be hosting the FA Cup Semi Final football match between Coventry City and Manchester United, with kick off at 15:30. Large crowds and increased traffic levels are expected before and after the match.

London Marathon

From 04:00 until 21:00 on Sunday 21 April, extensive road closures will be in place across central, south and south east London for the London Marathon. The route will start in Blackheath and end on The Mall. Taxi ranks within the road closures will be inaccessible.

Demonstrations

Westminster

From 10:00 until 14:00 on Saturday 20 April, a march will take place, starting at the Chinese Embassy and ending at Richmond Terrace. Large crowds are expected.

Central London

From 10:30 until 14:30 on Saturday 20 April, a march will take place from Millbank to Temple Place via

Abingdon Street, Parliament Square, Whitehall, Horse Guards Avenue and Embankment. Large crowds are expected.

Road updates

Billinton Hill, East Croydon station

Until Thursday 25 April, Billinton Hill will be closed for engineering works. Taxis should use the taxi rank on Lansdowne Road where space will also be provided for PHV drop-offs and pick-ups. Travel Ambassadors will be at the station to help direct passengers to Lansdowne Road and will provide assistance to passengers with accessibility needs.

Ealing Road

Temporary traffic lights are currently in place between Ealing Road and its junction with Brentford High Street to support construction works. These works are expected to be in place until the end of July. Increased traffic is expected

Rank suspensions

The following ranks will be out of service:
